Who

The Chamber Blue of Kansas AHP is available as of January 2024, to employers who have acceptable risk and:

- Are active members in good standing with your local, participating chamber.
- Have 50 or fewer full-time equivalent employees.
- Will pay 25% of the lowest cost option.
- Meet underwriting and risk requirements of Chamber Blue of Kansas for businesses enrolling for the first time.
- Complete the required employee survey and provide rating documentation if you are a new business looking to enroll in Chamber Blue of Kansas for the first time. If you are currently enrolled in the Chamber Blue of Kansas association, you do not need to complete this survey.

Note: If you join the AHP and then leave, you must wait three years to re-enroll.

When

- 1 July 1 – August 18, 2023:** Interest survey.
- 2 October 2023:** Rates will be announced.
- 3 November 2023:** Enrollment begins with the support of Blue Cross.
